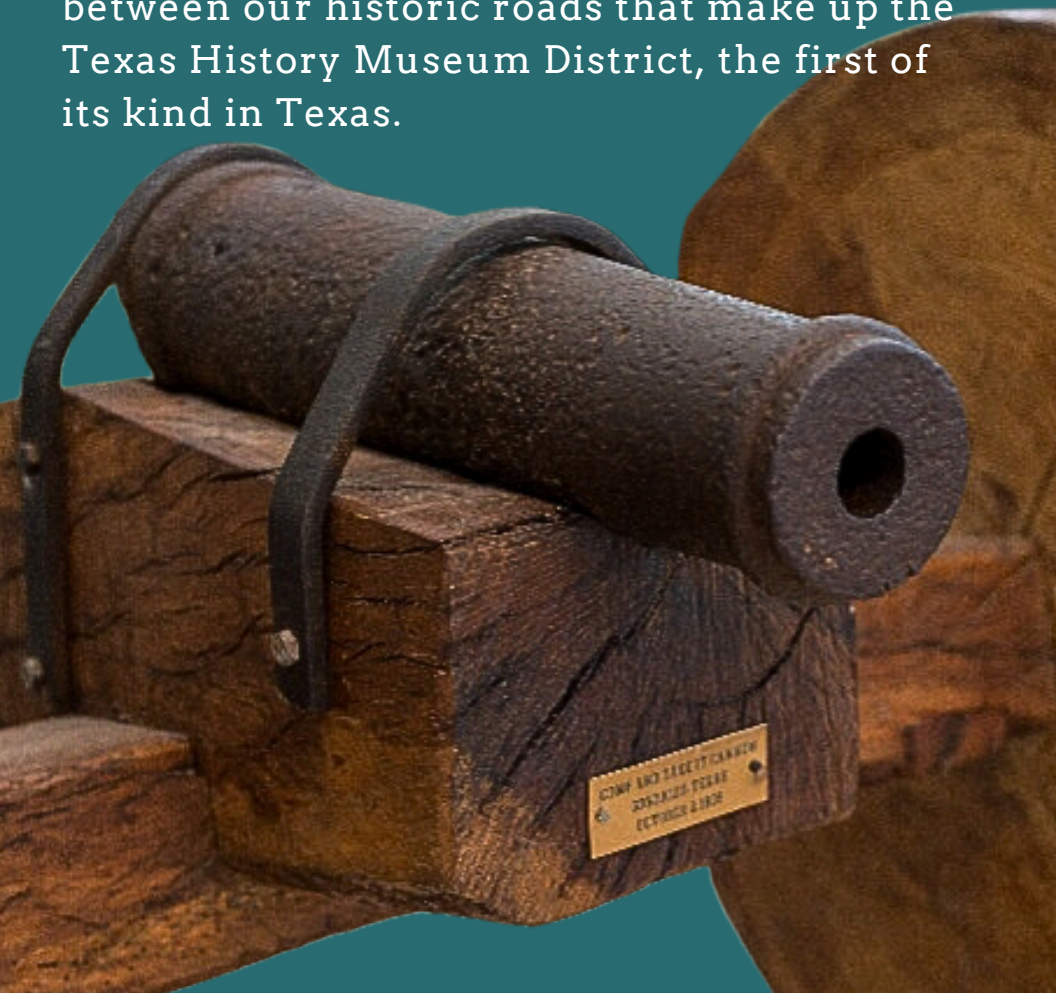
COME AND TAKE IT

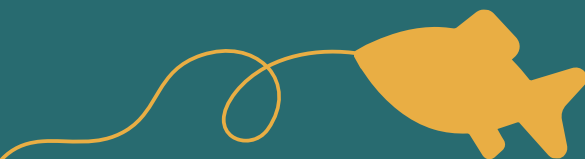
PADDLING TRAILS

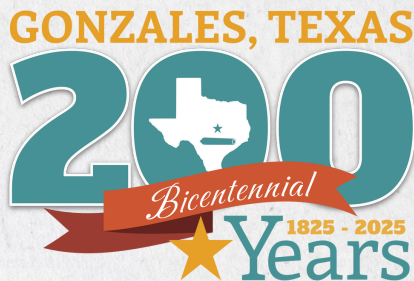
